

Procedures for Patients Having Hospital Dentistry

1. The patient must have a History and Physical performed by a physician who is on the medical staff of Henry Medical Center. The hospital will not accept H&P's performed by physicians not on staff at Henry General. The patient must set up an appointment by calling this physician's office. The physician Dr. Daniel has recommended to you is:

2. The patient must have a pre-operative assessment at Henry General Hospital in the Ambulatory Department. They will get financial and insurance information, necessary blood work and x-rays from the patient. Also, a representative from the Department of Anesthesia will evaluate the patient.
3. The patient must remember not to have anything to eat or drink after midnight the night before the case.
4. Dr. Daniel's office is not responsible for making arrangements with the hospital. That is the responsibility of the patient. All Dr. Daniel has the authority to do is admit the patient and render the services agreed upon by the patient before hand.
5. Fees charged by Dr. Daniel are not included in the hospital charges. Do not hesitate to obtain an estimate from Dr. Daniel's office before the case is done.
6. Remember to take this form with you when you have your History and Physical performed and show it to the physician so he/she will know why you have the appointment.
